SUBJECT: Fiscal Assessment of Proposed Amendment **HB1010_L.001**.

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed Amendment L.001 to House Bill 20-1010. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment only. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

Summary of Proposed Amendment

Amendment L.001 clarifies that the Department of Corrections will only need to collect data on whether an individual is Hispanic.

Fiscal Impact of Amendment

Amendment L.001 removes the requirement that the DOC create a new data field in its database to distinguish whether an offender is Latino or Hispanic. Instead, the DOC only needs to collect data on whether an offender is Hispanic. The DOC already collects this data and will require no change to its database, thus removing the \$15,945 computer programming impact in the fiscal note dated January 21, 2020.

Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment

As amended by Amendment L.001, the bill will increase workloads in the Department of Corrections and the Legislative Department. No change in appropriations is required.
