HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Transportation, Housing & Local Government.

HB25-1060 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 10 through 12 and substitute
2 "INTRUSION ON REAL PROPERTY THAT IS USED FOR BUSINESS PURPOSES,
3 TRANSMIT A SIGNAL TO THE BUSINESS, A MONITORING COMPANY
4 AUTHORIZED BY THE BUSINESS OWNER, OR LAW ENFORCEMENT SO THAT
5 THE BUSINESS OR LAW".

6 Page 2, line 16, strike "ANCILLARY" and substitute "INTEGRATED".

7 Page 2, line 21, strike "AND".

8 Page 3, strike lines 2 through 3 and substitute "BUSINESS, A MONITORING
9 COMPANY AUTHORIZED BY THE BUSINESS OWNER, OR LAW ENFORCEMENT;

10 (d) IS NOT LOCATED ON REAL PROPERTY THAT HAS BEEN
11 DESIGNATED BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT AS EXCLUSIVELY FOR RESIDENTIAL
12 USE;

13 (e) IS LOCATED BEHIND A NONELECTRIC PERIMETER FENCE OR
14 WALL THAT IS NOT LESS THAN FIVE FEET IN HEIGHT;

15 (f) IS THE TALLER OF:

16 (I) TEN FEET IN HEIGHT; OR

17 (II) TWO FEET TALLER THAN THE HEIGHT OF THE NONELECTRIC
18 PERIMETER FENCE OR WALL; AND

19 (g) IS MARKED WITH CONSPICUOUS WARNING SIGNS THAT ARE
20 LOCATED ON THE FENCE AT NOT MORE THAN THIRTY-FOOT INTERVALS AND
21 THAT READ: "WARNING: ELECTRIC FENCE".

22 Page 3, after line 19 insert:

23 "(4) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION GRANTS A LOCAL GOVERNMENT THE
24 AUTHORITY TO PROHIBIT OR REGULATE THE USE OF AN ELECTRONIC FENCE
25 DETECTION SYSTEM IN AN AREA THAT IS NOT ZONED EXCLUSIVELY FOR
26 RESIDENTIAL USE."

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
