

**Letter from Adrian Trujillo, Taryn's husband on the second anniversary of her death**

"Taryn,

Two years ago January 29 2017 was by far the toughest day of my life . It was the day my son was born but also the day I lost him and my loving wife . It was such a weird mix of emotion because when you first see your child it's supposed to be a happy moment , and it was . But it also was so terrible knowing that he wouldn't make it much longer . I remember sitting there holding him , I was so freaking proud let me tell you that dude was beautiful , I was proud because we made him . As badly I wanted to show him off to the world I knew the world wasn't ready for him . That morning I held my son Kayan William Trujillo in my arms until he passed away . I hold many regrets in my heart but one that has always got me is I regret never seeing his eyes , I bet they were as blue as yours . That day was so full of terror and I spent so long trying to block it out of my memories then one day I realized it's so apart of me that it would be impossible . I remember singing to you as you passed away , I had so much going on that I felt stupid later because I picked a song that you hated , lol but for whatever reason you used to love to listen to me sing regardless of how awful I am . I died in that hospital with you that night , but the man I was reborn into made a promise that I wouldn't make the same mistakes , I would appreciate life so much more , I would give the world to those that deserve it , I would buy more flowers because you loved flowers so much and I didn't buy nearly enough ! I'm writing this to you both as an update , I'm still making mistakes .. but I'm still standing , I'm growing into the man that you always deserved . I'm fighting everyday to be better. I'm still learning so many lessons and I'm learning that people are either there to teach you or learn from you and that they will judge you for who other people say you are . But I've also learned the only thing that matters is that I stay true to who god says I am . I promise you I will never stop loving as hard as I can . Loving you , loving god , loving family , thank you for teaching me , thank you for putting up with me , and thanks for guiding me to glory . I love you guys with all of my heart . Happy second birthday my son ."
