INTERIM COMMITTEE AMENDMENT
Zero Waste and Recycling Interim Study Committee.

BY REPRESENTATIVE Cutter
LLS No. 20-0311/BILL 3 be amended as follows:

1 Amend LLS No. 20-0311/BILL 3, page 2, line 10, strike
2 "SEQUESTRATION"" and substitute "STORAGE"".

3 Page 3, line 9, after "(1)" insert "(a)".

4 Page 3, line 14, strike "SEQUESTRATION." and substitute "STORAGE.".

5 Page 3, after line 16 insert:

6 "(b) THE DEPARTMENT MAY INCORPORATE THE PLAN DESCRIBED
7 IN SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION INTO THE WORK THE DEPARTMENT
8 IS ALREADY DOING WITH REGARD TO ORGANICS MANAGEMENT IF THE
9 DEPARTMENT'S EXISTING WORK REGARDING ORGANICS MANAGEMENT
10 MEETS THE STANDARDS SET FORTH IN THIS ARTICLE 17.5.".

11 Page 4, line 18, after "FOR" insert "INVESTMENT TAX CREDIT UNDER
12 SECTION 39-30-104 AS".

13 Page 5, strike lines 5 through 21 and substitute:

14 "(A) INNOVATIVE WAYS TO CREATE: FINANCIAL OR OTHER
15 INCENTIVES TO ENCOURAGE THE VOLUNTARY USE OF COMPOST IN
16 AGRICULTURE TO PROMOTE CARBON STORAGE IN SOIL; AND INCENTIVES
17 FOR OTHER END USES, INCLUDING CONDUCTING A STUDY OF CARBON
18 STORAGE POTENTIAL IN COLORADO SOILS, DEVELOPING GOALS, MANAGING
19 DATA, IDENTIFYING GRANT OPPORTUNITIES, AND PROVIDING TECHNICAL
20 ASSISTANCE;

21 (B) A STATE PROCUREMENT STANDARD ESTABLISHING A
22 REQUIREMENT THAT A STATE-FUNDED PUBLIC PROJECT THAT SPECIFIES A
23 SOIL AMENDMENT USE COMPOST THAT IS SOURCED FROM A
24 STATE-PERMITTED COMPOST FACILITY AND CERTIFIED BY A NATIONALLY
25 RECOGNIZED THIRD PARTY; AND

26 (C) THE DEVELOPMENT OF SAMPLE PROCUREMENT LANGUAGE
27 THAT A LOCAL GOVERNMENT COULD USE IN ITS PROCUREMENT PROCESS,
28 SUCH AS LANGUAGE REQUIRING A MINIMUM OF FIVE PERCENT ORGANIC
29 MATTER IN CONSTRUCTION AND LANDSCAPING PROJECTS.".
