Thank you for the opportunity testify on this bill.

My response is general but also directed to sec 6
A&B.

Generally this bill overreaches; it reflects a
misunderstanding of social institutions. It misuses
terminology. And will likely hurt the very people it
claims to help.

For clarification:

Point 1-

1) Morality and ethics is basically the same thing
and share the same origin, it's called the natural law.

NL can be violated.

2) Morality and ethics is the product of human
reasoning and logic; from the natural moral law.

This has been the case since the first humans walked the face of the earth. This bill seems oblivious to this fact.

3) The origin of morality therefore is not churches even though they actively promote moral standards; churches did not invent moral rules, nor create ethical standards themselves. For example if you got rid of all churches there still would be objective standards, there still would be right and wrong, good and bad. This bill suggests there are no standards and seems to be libertine in its recommendations and expected outcome.

Point 2-

4) Logic maps onto morality, morality maps onto to logic. Immorality is essentially irrationality. Most churches simply recognize this fact of morality and

choose to teach it. Likewise the state has always had the same responsibility in legislative activities to pass laws that are also logical and reasonable. Yet this bill fails to embrace reason rather instead the personal whim of minors and partisan supporters.

5) Having described (in light of) natural law ethics, Sec 6 a&b now becomes completely incomprehensible. There is far too much in confusion in this bill to unravel in short order. How the terminology is used reflects a misunderstanding and a lack of education in the categories mentioned.

6) This bill contradicts itself because it is highly ideological politically and socially sectarian but then turns and warns against ideology and sectarian influence. This bill is blind to its own prejudice,

whether wittingly or unwittingly. It pretends to have the high ground. Actually this bill is very arrogant.

7) This bill by design openly blocks any reasonable alternative points of view.

8) It violates parental rights. It burdens schools with not just an overreaction, but burdens many students with a course they may not want or need to take.

This program proposal will waste tax payer money.
