HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Finance.

HB25-1208 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 16 through 19 and substitute
2 "offset if permitted by state law.
- 3 (B) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT SHALL DETERMINE THE AMOUNT OF
4 THE TIP OFFSET IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (3.5) OF THIS SECTION.
- 5 (C) A BUSINESS OR ENTERPRISE THAT PREPARES AND OFFERS FOR
6 SALE FOOD OR BEVERAGES AND EMPLOYS TIPPED EMPLOYEES SHALL PAY
7 ENOUGH IN DIRECT WAGES FOR TOTAL PAY, INCLUDING TIPS, TO ALLOW
8 EACH TIPPED EMPLOYEE TO RECEIVE AT LEAST THE LOCAL MINIMUM WAGE
9 IN EACH WORK WEEK. IF SUCH AN EMPLOYER PAYS DIRECT WAGES TO A
10 TIPPED EMPLOYEE IN AN AMOUNT THAT IS LESS THAN THE LOCAL MINIMUM
11 WAGE, AND THE TIPPED EMPLOYEE'S TIPS ARE INSUFFICIENT TO RAISE THE
12 TIPPED EMPLOYEE'S TOTAL PAY TO THE LOCAL MINIMUM WAGE, THEN THE
13 EMPLOYER SHALL MAKE UP THE DIFFERENCE IN DIRECT WAGES.
- 14 (D) A local government shall not include in its minimum wage".
