# Cons of National Popular Vote

1. NPV is a dishonest run around the constitution
  - a. More about securing power for the democratic party than representing the people
2. Encourages lazy campaigning
  - a. Discourages coalition building
  - b. Candidates need only campaign in most populous states
3. Disenfranchises voters of the state of Colorado
  - a. Suppresses the voice of minority opinions, especially those in rural areas
  - b. Devalues votes by throwing them away to larger states
  - c. Tyranny of the majority
  - d. Steals the voice from regions affected by natural disasters during elections
4. Robs Colorado of its sovereignty
  - a. Colorado unfairly affected by voting codes of other states
  - b. Exposes Colorado to election fraud carried out in other states
5. History shows that direct democracies often fail
  - a. Pure democracies do not work, but rather implode via tyranny of the majority
  - b. ex Athens, Greece
