

**UPDATED SUMMARY
SENATE BILL 19-025**

First Regular Session - Seventy-second Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

If a school district, charter school, institute charter school, or board of cooperative services (school) chooses to provide a ~~planned curriculum that includes~~ *local* comprehensive ~~human sexuality~~ *health* education *program pursuant to article 25 of title 22, C.R.S.*, the school's curriculum must include information relating to state laws that provide for the safe abandonment of newborn children to specific persons, including firefighters and clinic or hospital staff, within 72 hours of birth.
