SB19-236 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 16, after line 26 insert:

2 "SECTION 15. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 40-6-109, amend
3 (1) as follows:

4 **40-6-109. Hearings - orders - record - review - representation**
5 **of entities in nonadjudicatory proceedings.** (1) At the time fixed for
6 any A hearing before the commission, any A commissioner, or an
7 administrative law judge, or, at the time to which the ~~same~~ HEARING may
8 have been continued, the applicant, petitioner, complainant; the person,
9 firm, or corporation complained of; and ~~such persons, firms, or~~
10 ~~corporations~~ ANY PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION as the commission may
11 allow to intervene ~~and such persons, firms, or corporations as will be~~
12 THAT IS interested in or affected by any A COMMISSION order that may be
13 ~~made by the commission~~ in such THE proceeding and ~~who shall have~~
14 THAT HAS become parties A PARTY to the proceeding ~~shall be~~ IS entitled
15 to be heard, examine and cross-examine witnesses, and introduce
16 evidence. AN INDIVIDUAL CUSTOMER OF A REGULATED UTILITY IS
17 AUTHORIZED TO INTERVENE IN A MATTER BEFORE THE COMMISSION THAT
18 AFFECTS THE CUSTOMER. A full and complete record of all proceedings
19 ~~had~~ before the commission, any A commissioner, or an administrative law
20 judge in any formal hearing and all testimony shall be taken down by any
21 A reporter appointed by the commission or RECORDED ELECTRONICALLY
22 as deemed appropriate by the commission, a commissioner, or an
23 administrative law judge, as applicable. ~~recorded electronically~~: All
24 parties in interest ~~shall be~~ ARE entitled to be heard in person or TO BE
25 REPRESENTED by attorney."
