As parent of a service-related disabled veteran left homeless by a SWAT raid on her Denver house while on wait lists for opioid treatment, I feel that this is definitely something we citizens should know and understand. I am hoping someone will ask this question of the AG and get an answer because too many of us are sick and tired of living in fear of the police. And my husband and I are law-abiding, tax-paying, home-owner citizens.
