Ms. Jensen:

I am unable to attend the hearing on 03-13-19. Please include the following statement in the hearing captioned above.

*To the Committee,*

*I retired from community corrections and State Probation in 2016 after 41 years service. Since that time I have joined two County Corrections Boards. I continue my passion for helping offenders exit the system in a positive fashion and I am speaking for myself: NOT as a representative of Corrections Boards.*

*Having lived in Jefferson County since 1958 I have had been involved with several meetings at Camp George West (CGW). Those meetings were held in order to educate the Pleasant View neighbors to CGW about the DOC population in the facility. It was reiterated to this community that offenders would not have access to the community. That has held true for many years.*

*In redefining CGW from a Level I correctional facility to a Level 0 Transitional facility a number of offenders will have immediate access to the community of Pleasant View, Golden, Applewood and Lakewood. As I understand the bill, offenders would not face any review and approval process by the Jefferson County Corrections Board. I know this will not fare well with the immediate communities.*

*South Golden Road is a local road that connects to Highway 40 and 6th Avenue (at Indiana) and to the west...Golden. I trust there has been little thought to the impact on local traffic; be it by residential offenders or the parolees it is additionally defined to serve with re-entry support modalities. The impact on the Sheriff's Office and the Pleasant View Volunteer Fire Department will be costly.*

*I fear this is a step toward removing local control across the State. A step that minimizes the good efforts by the Office of Community Corrections of DCJ to help boards across the state increase the acceptance of Transition offenders in communities.*

*I foresee the DOC designating the Rifle Correctional Facility to a Level 0 Transitional Facility: a move that will impact the 9th and 21st Judicial Districts' corrections boards AS WELL AS the*
