HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Transportation & Energy.

HB18-1103 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 16 and 17 and substitute "city, or
2 town may, ~~require the driver who is driving~~ WHEN an off-highway vehicle
3 IS BEING DRIVEN on a street, road, or highway within the jurisdiction of
4 the county,".

5 Page 3, strike lines 20 through 23 and substitute:

6 "(A) REQUIRE THE DRIVER TO have a driver's license; ~~or~~
7 (B) REQUIRE THE DRIVER TO carry liability insurance;
8 (C) REQUIRE THE OCCUPANTS TO WEAR A SAFETY BELT SYSTEM IF
9 THE MANUFACTURER INSTALLED A SAFETY BELT SYSTEM".

10 Page 4, line 2, strike "PROTECTION;" and substitute "PROTECTION FOR ALL
11 OCCUPANTS IN THE OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE;"

12 Page 4, strike lines 3 through 5 and substitute:

13 "(F) REQUIRE THE USE OF A HELMET FOR AN OCCUPANT WHO IS
14 UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE; OR".

15 Page 4, line 7, strike "HOLD." and substitute "HOLD, BUT IF THE
16 OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE IS AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE, LIMIT THE NUMBER
17 OF OCCUPANTS TO TWO.".

18 Page 4, after line 14 insert:

19 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14.5-101, **amend**
20 (1); and **add** (1.5) as follows:

21 **33-14.5-101. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the
22 context otherwise requires:

23 (1) ~~"Dealer" means a person engaged in the business of selling~~
24 ~~off-highway vehicles at wholesale or retail in this state~~ "ALL-TERRAIN
25 VEHICLE" HAS THE MEANING SET FORTH IN SECTION 42-6-102.

26 (1.5) "DEALER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF
27 SELLING OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES AT WHOLESALE OR RETAIL IN THIS
28 STATE.".
