I am pleased to submit the Department of Local Affairs' (DOLA) 2019 Regulatory Agenda which details the new rules or amendments DOLA expects to propose in the next calendar year, as well as the 2018 Regulatory Agenda Report which details the results of the past year's regulatory activity, in compliance with Colo. Rev. Stat. §2-7-203, as amended by House Bill 12-1008. The Department's 2018 Regulatory Agenda has also been submitted to the Colorado Secretary of State for publication in the Colorado Register, and will be posted to the DOLA website.

Effective July 1, 2018, all permanent rules adopted by the Department, as reflected in the 2018 Regulatory Agenda Report, involved early stakeholder engagement, as described by the Department's procedures for public participation in rulemaking (available online at <https://docs.google.com/document/d/11qtgOtTBVGhmLmjp1aJlxOL3c2mi4GHY65edB-jdGG8/edit?usp=sharing>).
