SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.

SB18-157 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 4, strike lines 10 through 13 and substitute:  
2 "(d) TO LOCATE WOMEN WHO RELOCATE TO COLORADO AFTER  
3 THEY ARE DISCHARGED FROM THE MILITARY;"
- 4 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 7 and substitute:  
5 "(u) COORDINATE AND CONFER WITH ALL STATE AGENCIES TO  
6 SUPPORT WOMEN VETERANS;"
- 7 Page 6, line 11, strike "AND".
- 8 Page 6, strike line 14 and substitute:  
9 "VETERANS; AND  
10 (z) IMPROVE WOMEN VETERANS' ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE AND  
11 BEHAVIORAL AND MENTAL HEALTH CARE.  
12 (4) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT SEVEN MEMBERS TO THE STATE  
13 WOMEN VETERANS STEERING COMMITTEE. EACH APPOINTEE MUST BE A  
14 VETERAN. EACH MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR MUST REPRESENT  
15 ONE OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS: AN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITY IN  
16 COLORADO; RURAL COLORADO; AN URBAN AREA IN COLORADO; THE  
17 HEALTH CARE INDUSTRY; THE BUSINESS INDUSTRY; EDUCATION  
18 PROVIDERS; AND THE VOCATIONAL INDUSTRY."
- 19 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.
- 20 Page 6, line 20, strike "MAINTAIN" and substitute "ENGAGE AND  
21 PARTICIPATE IN".
- 22 Page 6, strike lines 26 and 27 and substitute:  
23 "(6) TOGETHER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND  
24 VETERANS AFFAIRS, THE WOMEN VETERANS SERVICE OFFICER SHALL  
25 APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE AND PRESENT THE  
26 PERFORMANCE OF THE SWVO TO THE "STATE MEASUREMENT FOR  
27 ACCOUNTABLE, RESPONSIVE, AND TRANSPARENT (SMART)  
28 GOVERNMENT ACT" HEARINGS CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO SECTION  
29 2-7-203."
- 30 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 3.
