HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.HB17-1056 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, after line 10 insert:

2 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-4-1301.4, amend
3 (3) as follows:

4 42-4-1301.4. Useful public service - definitions - local
5 programs - assessment of costs. (3) (a) There may be established in the
6 probation department of each judicial district in the state a useful public
7 service program under the direction of the chief probation officer. It is the
8 purpose of the useful public service program: To identify and seek the
9 cooperation of governmental entities and political subdivisions thereof,
10 as well as corporations organized not for profit or charitable trusts, AS
11 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (3)(c) OF THIS SECTION, for the purpose of
12 providing useful public service jobs; to interview and assign persons who
13 have been ordered by the court to perform useful public service to
14 suitable useful public service jobs; and to monitor compliance or
15 noncompliance of such persons in performing useful public service
16 assignments within the time established by the court.

17 (b) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION (3) LIMITS THE AUTHORITY OF
18 AN ENTITY THAT IS THE RECIPIENT OF COMMUNITY OR USEFUL PUBLIC
19 SERVICE TO ACCEPT OR REJECT SUCH SERVICE, IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION.

20 (c) IN ADDITION TO GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES AND POLITICAL
21 SUBDIVISIONS THEREOF, THE FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS ARE ELIGIBLE
22 TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY OR USEFUL PUBLIC SERVICE JOBS ESTABLISHED
23 UNDER THIS SECTION OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW SO LONG AS THEY
24 MEET ANY OTHER REQUIREMENT RELATED TO THE PROVISION OF THOSE
25 JOBS, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE ENTITY THAT IS THE RECIPIENT OF
26 COMMUNITY OR USEFUL PUBLIC SERVICE:

27 (I) A CHARITABLE TRUST OR OTHER ORGANIZATION THAT IS
28 EXEMPT FROM TAXATION UNDER SECTION 501 (c)(3) OF THE FEDERAL
29 "INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986", AS AMENDED;

30 (II) A CIVIC LEAGUE OR ORGANIZATION THAT IS EXEMPT FROM
31 TAXATION UNDER SECTION 501 (c)(4) OF THE FEDERAL "INTERNAL
32 REVENUE CODE OF 1986", AS AMENDED, AND THAT ALSO WOULD QUALIFY
33 AS A VETERANS' SERVICE ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN SECTION 501
34 (c)(19) OF THE FEDERAL "INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986", AS
35 AMENDED; AND

36 (III) A VETERANS' SERVICE ORGANIZATION THAT IS EXEMPT FROM
37 TAXATION UNDER SECTION 501 (c)(19) OF THE FEDERAL "INTERNAL
