

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.SB19-202 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 4, strike "**disabilities.**" and
2 substitute "**a disability. (1)**".
- 3 Page 2, line 5, strike "VOTERS" and substitute "A VOTER".
- 4 Page 2, line 6, strike "DISABILITIES" and substitute "A DISABILITY" and
5 after "INDEPENDENTLY" insert "AND PRIVATELY".
- 6 Page 2, lines 8 and 9, strike "NONVISUAL ACCESS OR LOW VISION ACCESS
7 TECHNOLOGY WHETHER THE VOTER IS VOTING" and substitute
8 "NONVISUAL ACCESS, LOW-VISION ACCESS, OR OTHER ASSISTIVE
9 TECHNOLOGY IN ORDER FOR THE VOTER TO VOTE".
- 10 Page 2, line 10, strike "TITLE 1 OR VOTING AT A POLLING LOCATION." and
11 substitute "TITLE 1."
- 12 Page 2, after line 13 insert:
- 13 "(2) (a) A VOTER WITH A DISABILITY WHO REQUESTS THAT A
14 BALLOT AND BALLOTING MATERIALS BE SENT TO THE VOTER BY
15 ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION MAY CHOOSE ELECTRONIC MAIL DELIVERY OR,
16 IF OFFERED BY THE VOTER'S JURISDICTION, OTHER ELECTRONIC MEANS.
17 THE DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL IN EACH JURISDICTION CHARGED
18 WITH DISTRIBUTING A BALLOT AND BALLOTING MATERIALS SHALL
19 TRANSMIT THE BALLOT AND BALLOTING MATERIALS TO THE VOTER USING
20 THE MEANS OF TRANSMISSION CHOSEN BY THE VOTER.
- 21 (b) IF A BALLOT APPLICATION FROM A VOTER WITH A DISABILITY
22 ARRIVES AFTER THE JURISDICTION BEGINS TRANSMITTING BALLOTS AND
23 BALLOTING MATERIALS TO VOTERS, THE OFFICIAL CHARGED WITH
24 DISTRIBUTING A BALLOT AND BALLOTING MATERIALS SHALL TRANSMIT
25 THEM TO THE VOTER WITHIN SEVENTY-TWO HOURS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF
26 THE APPLICATION.
- 27 (c) A VOTER WITH A DISABILITY WHO RECEIVES A BALLOT
28 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (2) MUST PRINT THE BALLOT SENT BY
29 ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION AND SUCH BALLOT MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE
30 ELECTION OFFICIAL IN THE APPLICABLE JURISDICTION BEFORE THE CLOSE
31 OF POLLS ON THE DAY OF THE ELECTION."
