 Committee on Cost-benefit Analysis of Legalized Marijuana  
in Colorado.

LLS No. 17-0134/BILL 7 be amended as follows:

1 Amend LLS No. 17-0134/BILL 7, strike everything below the enacting  
 2 clause and substitute the following:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-104, add  
 4 (14.7) as follows:

5 12-43.3-104. **Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the  
 6 context otherwise requires:

7 (14.7) "SALES ROOM" MEANS A SEPARATE LOCATION OF A MEDICAL  
 8 MARIJUANA CENTER IN WHICH A LICENSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER  
 9 SELLS AND SERVES MEDICAL MARIJUANA, MEDICAL MARIJUANA  
 10 CONCENTRATE, AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCTS FOR  
 11 CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES.

12 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-202, amend  
 13 (1)(h) and (2.5)(a) introductory portion; and add (2.5)(a)(IV) as follows:

14 12-43.3-202. **Powers and duties of state licensing authority -**  
 15 **rules.** (1) The state licensing authority shall:

16 (h) Develop and maintain a seed-to-sale tracking system that  
 17 tracks medical marijuana from either the seed or immature plant stage  
 18 until the medical marijuana or medical marijuana-infused product is sold  
 19 to a customer at a medical marijuana center OR SALES ROOM to ensure that  
 20 no medical marijuana grown or processed by a medical marijuana  
 21 establishment is sold or otherwise transferred except by a medical  
 22 marijuana center.

23 (2.5) (a) Rules promulgated pursuant to ~~paragraph (b) of~~  
 24 ~~subsection (1)~~ SUBSECTION (1)(b) of this section must include, but need  
 25 not be limited to, the following subjects:

26 (IV) (A) LICENSED SALES ROOMS OPERATED BY LICENSED  
 27 MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTERS; AND

28 (B) POINT-OF-SALE SAFE CONSUMPTION INFORMATION FOR  
 29 LICENSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA SALES ROOMS IN CONSULTATION WITH THE  
 30 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT.

31 SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-301, amend  
 32 (1)(d) and (1)(e); and add (1)(f) as follows:

33 12-43.3-301. **Local licensing authority - applications - licenses.**

34 (1) A local licensing authority may issue only the following medical  
 35 marijuana licenses upon payment of the fee and compliance with all local  
 36 licensing requirements to be determined by the local licensing authority:

37 (d) A medical marijuana testing facility license; and

38 (e) A medical marijuana transporter license; AND

39 (f) A MEDICAL MARIJUANA SALES ROOM LICENSE.

1           **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-401, add  
2 (1)(f) as follows:

3           **12-43.3-401. Classes of licenses.** (1) For the purpose of  
4 regulating the cultivation, manufacture, distribution, and sale of medical  
5 marijuana, the state licensing authority in its discretion, upon application  
6 in the prescribed form made to it, may issue and grant to the applicant a  
7 license from any of the following classes, subject to the provisions and  
8 restrictions provided by this article:

9           (f) MEDICAL MARIJUANA SALES ROOM LICENSE.

10           **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-402, add  
11 (1)(c) as follows:

12           **12-43.3-402. Medical marijuana center license.** (1) (c) A  
13 LICENSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER MAY OPERATE ONLY ONE  
14 LICENSED SALES ROOM PER MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER LICENSE IF THE  
15 MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER IS IN A JURISDICTION THAT PERMITS THE  
16 SALE OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA BUT DOES NOT PERMIT THE SALE OF RETAIL  
17 MARIJUANA. THE SALES ROOM MUST BE PHYSICALLY SEPARATE FROM THE  
18 MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER OPERATION AND MUST BE LOCATED IN THE  
19 SAME JURISDICTION AS THE MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER OPERATION.

20           **SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 12-43.3-407 as  
21 follows:

22           **12-43.3-407. Medical marijuana sales room.** (1) THE  
23 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION ONLY APPLY WITHIN A COUNTY, CITY, CITY  
24 AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY IF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY,  
25 CITY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY ADOPTS AN ORDINANCE OR  
26 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SALES ROOMS. THE ORDINANCE OR  
27 RESOLUTION MAY PROVIDE FOR STRICTER LIMITS THAN THIS SECTION.

28           (2) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY ISSUE A MEDICAL  
29 MARIJUANA SALES ROOM LICENSE ONLY TO A PERSON WITH AN EXISTING  
30 MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER LICENSE TO SELL MEDICAL MARIJUANA,  
31 MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR MEDICAL MARIJUANA-INFUSED  
32 PRODUCTS FOR ON-SITE CONSUMPTION IN A JURISDICTION THAT PERMITS  
33 THE SALE OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA BUT DOES NOT PERMIT THE SALE OF  
34 RETAIL MARIJUANA.

35           (3) (a) (I) PRIOR TO OPERATING A SALES ROOM, A MEDICAL  
36 MARIJUANA CENTER LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL, AT THE  
37 TIME OF APPLICATION TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY, SEND A COPY  
38 OF THE APPLICATION FOR A MEDICAL MARIJUANA SALES ROOM LICENSE TO  
39 THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY IN THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH THE  
40 SALES ROOM IS PROPOSED. THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY SUBMIT  
41 A RESPONSE TO THE APPLICATION, INCLUDING ITS DETERMINATION, TO THE  
42 STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY BUT MUST SUBMIT ITS RESPONSE WITHIN  
43 FORTY-FIVE DAYS AFTER THE LICENSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER

1 SUBMITS ITS SALES ROOM APPLICATION TO THE STATE LICENSING  
2 AUTHORITY.

3 (II) IF THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY DOES NOT SUBMIT A  
4 RESPONSE TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD  
5 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (3)(a)(I) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE LICENSING  
6 AUTHORITY SHALL DEEM THAT THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY HAS  
7 DETERMINED THAT THE APPLICANT'S PROPOSED SALES ROOM WILL NOT  
8 IMPACT TRAFFIC, NOISE, OR OTHER NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS IN A  
9 MANNER THAT IS INCONSISTENT WITH LOCAL REGULATIONS OR  
10 ORDINANCES OR THAT THE APPLICANT WILL SUFFICIENTLY MITIGATE ANY  
11 IMPACTS IDENTIFIED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY.

12 (b) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL CONSIDER THE  
13 RESPONSE FROM THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY, IF ANY, AND MAY  
14 DENY THE PROPOSED SALES ROOM APPLICATION IF THE LOCAL LICENSING  
15 AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT:

16 (I) APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED SALES ROOM WILL IMPACT  
17 TRAFFIC, NOISE, OR OTHER NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS IN A MANNER THAT  
18 IS INCONSISTENT WITH LOCAL REGULATIONS OR ORDINANCES, WHICH MAY  
19 BE DETERMINED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY WITHOUT  
20 REQUIRING A PUBLIC HEARING; OR

21 (II) THE APPLICANT CANNOT SUFFICIENTLY MITIGATE ANY  
22 POTENTIAL IMPACTS IDENTIFIED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY.

23 (c) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL NOT GRANT  
24 APPROVAL OF A SALES ROOM UNLESS THE APPLICANT AFFIRMS TO THE  
25 STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY THAT THE APPLICANT HAS COMPLIED WITH  
26 LOCAL ZONING RESTRICTIONS.

27 (d) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL MAINTAIN A LIST OF  
28 ALL APPROVED SALES ROOMS IN THE STATE AND SHALL MAKE THE LIST  
29 AVAILABLE ON ITS WEBSITE.

30 (e) THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY REQUEST THAT THE  
31 STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY TAKE ACTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
32 SECTION 12-43.3-601 AGAINST A LICENSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER  
33 APPROVED TO OPERATE A SALES ROOM IF THE LOCAL LICENSING  
34 AUTHORITY:

35 (I) DEMONSTRATES TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY THAT  
36 THE LICENSEE HAS ENGAGED IN AN UNLAWFUL ACT AS SET FORTH IN PART  
37 9 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR

38 (II) SHOWS GOOD CAUSE AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 12-43.3-104(1).

39 (f) THIS SUBSECTION (3) DOES NOT APPLY IF THE LICENSED  
40 MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER DOES NOT SELL AND SERVE MEDICAL  
41 MARIJUANA FOR CONSUMPTION IN AN APPROVED SALES ROOM.

42 (4) (a) A PATRON SHALL NOT BRING MEDICAL OR RETAIL  
43 MARIJUANA, MEDICAL OR RETAIL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, A MEDICAL

1 MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCT, OR A RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCT INTO  
2 A SALES ROOM.

3 (b) A PATRON OF A SALES ROOM SHALL NOT LEAVE THE PREMISES  
4 OF A SALES ROOM WITH MEDICAL MARIJUANA, MEDICAL MARIJUANA  
5 CONCENTRATE, OR A MEDICAL MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCT PURCHASED  
6 AT THE SALES ROOM.

7 (5) (a) A SALES ROOM SHALL NOT OPERATE AS A RETAIL FOOD  
8 ESTABLISHMENT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 25-4-1602 (14).

9 (b) A SALES ROOM MAY NOT SELL ALCOHOL OR TOBACCO OR  
10 NICOTINE PRODUCTS OR ALLOW THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL OR  
11 TOBACCO OR NICOTINE PRODUCTS ON SITE.

12 (6) A SALES ROOM MAY ONLY ADMIT PERSONS WHO ARE  
13 TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER ONTO THE PREMISES.

14 (7) (a) A SALES ROOM MAY SELL NO MORE THAN ONE GRAM OF  
15 MEDICAL MARIJUANA FLOWER, ONE-QUARTER OF ONE GRAM OF MEDICAL  
16 MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR TEN MILLIGRAMS OF A MEDICAL  
17 MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCT TO A PERSON AT A TIME.

18 (b) WHEN A SALES ROOM SELLS MEDICAL MARIJUANA, MEDICAL  
19 MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR A MEDICAL MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCT,  
20 AN EMPLOYEE MUST REMOVE THE PACKAGING AT THE POINT OF SALE.

21 (8) (a) A SALES ROOM AND ITS EMPLOYEES SHALL CONDUCT THE  
22 LICENSED PREMISES IN A DECENT, ORDERLY, AND RESPECTABLE MANNER  
23 AND SHALL NOT SERVE ANY PERSON WHO DISPLAYS ANY VISIBLE SIGNS OF  
24 INTOXICATION; NOR SHALL THEY PERMIT ANY PERSON WHO DISPLAYS ANY  
25 VISIBLE SIGNS OF INTOXICATION TO REMAIN ON THE LICENSED PREMISES  
26 WITHOUT AN ACCEPTABLE PURPOSE; NOR SHALL THEY KNOWINGLY PERMIT  
27 ANY ACTIVITY OR ACTS OF DISORDERLY CONDUCT AS DEFINED BY AND  
28 PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 18-9-106; NOR SHALL THEY PERMIT ROWDINESS,  
29 UNDUE NOISE, OR OTHER DISTURBANCES OR ACTIVITY OFFENSIVE TO THE  
30 SENSES OF THE AVERAGE CITIZEN OR TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE  
31 NEIGHBORHOOD IN WHICH THE LICENSED ESTABLISHMENT IS LOCATED.

32 (b) A SALES ROOM SHALL NOT ALLOW THE USE OF A BUTANE  
33 TORCH, BUTANE LIGHTER, OR MATCHES IN A SALES ROOM.

34 (9) A SALES ROOM AND ITS EMPLOYEES SHALL SUCCESSFULLY  
35 COMPLETE A RESPONSIBLE VENDOR PROGRAM AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO  
36 SECTION 12-43.3-1102 ANNUALLY.

37 (10) A SALES ROOM SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION REGARDING THE  
38 SAFE CONSUMPTION OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE OR A MEDICAL  
39 MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCT AT THE POINT OF SALE TO ALL PATRONS  
40 WHO PURCHASE SUCH A PRODUCT.

41 (11) THE WINDOWS AND DOORS OF A SALES ROOM MUST BE  
42 OPAQUE, AND THE SALES ROOM SHALL ENSURE THAT ANY MEDICAL  
43 MARIJUANA, MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR MEDICAL

1 MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCT IS NOT VISIBLE FROM OUTSIDE OF THE  
2 SALES ROOM.

3 **SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-103, **add**  
4 (22.5) as follows:

5 **12-43.4-103. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the  
6 context otherwise requires:

7 (22.5) "SALES ROOM" MEANS A SEPARATE LOCATION OF A RETAIL  
8 MARIJUANA STORE IN WHICH A LICENSED RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE SELLS  
9 AND SERVES RETAIL MARIJUANA, RETAIL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, AND  
10 RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCTS FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED  
11 PREMISES.

12 **SECTION 8.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-202, **amend**  
13 (1), (3)(a) introductory portion, (3)(a)(XIX), (3)(a)(XX), (3)(c)  
14 introductory portion, and (3)(c)(VIII); and **add** (3)(a)(XXI) and (3)(c)(X)  
15 as follows:

16 **12-43.4-202. Powers and duties of state licensing authority -**  
17 **rules.** (1) The state licensing authority shall develop and maintain a  
18 seed-to-sale tracking system that tracks retail marijuana from either seed  
19 or immature plant stage until the marijuana or retail marijuana product is  
20 sold to a customer at a retail marijuana store OR A SALES ROOM to ensure  
21 that no marijuana grown or processed by a retail marijuana establishment  
22 is sold or otherwise transferred except by a retail marijuana store.

23 (3) (a) Rules promulgated pursuant to ~~paragraph (b) of subsection~~  
24 ~~(2)~~ SUBSECTION (2)(b) of this section must include, but need not be  
25 limited to, the following subjects:

26 (XIX) Nonescorted visitors in limited access areas; and

27 (XX) The parameters and qualifications of an indirect beneficial  
28 interest owner and a qualified limited passive investor; AND

29 (XXI) LICENSED SALES ROOMS OPERATED BY LICENSED RETAIL  
30 MARIJUANA STORES.

31 (c) Rules promulgated pursuant to ~~paragraph (b) of subsection (2)~~  
32 SUBSECTION (2)(b) of this section must also include the following  
33 subjects, and the state licensing authority may seek the assistance of the  
34 department of public health and environment when necessary before  
35 promulgating the rules:

36 (VIII) Permission for a local fire department to conduct an annual  
37 fire inspection of a retail marijuana cultivation facility; and

38 (X) POINT-OF-SALE SAFE CONSUMPTION INFORMATION FOR  
39 LICENSED RETAIL MARIJUANA SALES ROOMS.

40 **SECTION 9.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-401, **amend**  
41 (1)(f) and (1)(g); and **add** (1)(h) as follows:

42 **12-43.4-401. Classes of licenses.** (1) For the purpose of  
43 regulating the cultivation, manufacture, distribution, sale, and testing of

1 retail marijuana and retail marijuana products, the state licensing  
2 authority in its discretion, upon receipt of an application in the prescribed  
3 form, may issue and grant to the applicant a license from any of the  
4 following classes, subject to the provisions and restrictions provided by  
5 this article:

- 6 (f) Retail marijuana transporter license; and
- 7 (g) Retail marijuana business operator license; AND
- 8 (h) RETAIL MARIJUANA SALES ROOM LICENSE.

9 **SECTION 10.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-402, add  
10 (1)(f) as follows:

11 **12-43.4-402. Retail marijuana store license - definitions.**

12 (1) (f) A RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE MAY OPERATE ONLY ONE LICENSED  
13 SALES ROOM PER RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE LICENSE. THE SALES ROOM  
14 MUST BE PHYSICALLY SEPARATE FROM THE RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE  
15 OPERATION AND MUST BE LOCATED IN THE SAME JURISDICTION AS THE  
16 RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE OPERATION.

17 **SECTION 11.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 12-43.4-408 as  
18 follows:

19 **12-43.4-408. Retail marijuana sales room.** (1) THE PROVISIONS

20 OF THIS SECTION ONLY APPLY WITHIN A COUNTY, CITY, CITY AND COUNTY,  
21 OR MUNICIPALITY IF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY, CITY, CITY  
22 AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY ADOPTS AN ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION  
23 AUTHORIZING SALES ROOMS. THE ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION MAY  
24 PROVIDE FOR STRICTER LIMITS THAN THIS SECTION.

25 (2) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY ISSUE A RETAIL  
26 MARIJUANA SALES ROOM LICENSE ONLY TO A PERSON WITH AN EXISTING  
27 RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE LICENSE TO SELL RETAIL MARIJUANA, RETAIL  
28 MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCTS FOR ON-SITE  
29 CONSUMPTION.

30 (3) (a) (I) PRIOR TO OPERATING A SALES ROOM, A RETAIL  
31 MARIJUANA STORE LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL, AT THE  
32 TIME OF APPLICATION TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY, SEND A COPY  
33 OF THE APPLICATION FOR A RETAIL MARIJUANA SALES ROOM LICENSE TO  
34 THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY IN THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH THE  
35 SALES ROOM IS PROPOSED. THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY SUBMIT  
36 A RESPONSE TO THE APPLICATION, INCLUDING ITS DETERMINATION, TO THE  
37 STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY BUT MUST SUBMIT ITS RESPONSE WITHIN  
38 FORTY-FIVE DAYS AFTER THE LICENSED RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE  
39 SUBMITS ITS SALES ROOM APPLICATION TO THE STATE LICENSING  
40 AUTHORITY.

41 (II) IF THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY DOES NOT SUBMIT A  
42 RESPONSE TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD  
43 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (3)(a)(I) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE LICENSING

1 AUTHORITY SHALL DEEM THAT THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY HAS  
2 DETERMINED THAT THE APPLICANT'S PROPOSED SALES ROOM WILL NOT  
3 IMPACT TRAFFIC, NOISE, OR OTHER NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS IN A  
4 MANNER THAT IS INCONSISTENT WITH LOCAL REGULATIONS OR  
5 ORDINANCES OR THAT THE APPLICANT WILL SUFFICIENTLY MITIGATE ANY  
6 IMPACTS IDENTIFIED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY.

7 (b) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL CONSIDER THE  
8 RESPONSE FROM THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY, IF ANY, AND MAY  
9 DENY THE PROPOSED SALES ROOM APPLICATION IF THE LOCAL LICENSING  
10 AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT:

11 (I) APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED SALES ROOM WILL IMPACT  
12 TRAFFIC, NOISE, OR OTHER NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS IN A MANNER THAT  
13 IS INCONSISTENT WITH LOCAL REGULATIONS OR ORDINANCES, WHICH MAY  
14 BE DETERMINED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY WITHOUT  
15 REQUIRING A PUBLIC HEARING; OR

16 (II) THE APPLICANT CANNOT SUFFICIENTLY MITIGATE ANY  
17 POTENTIAL IMPACTS IDENTIFIED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY.

18 (c) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL NOT GRANT  
19 APPROVAL OF A SALES ROOM UNLESS THE APPLICANT AFFIRMS TO THE  
20 STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY THAT THE APPLICANT HAS COMPLIED WITH  
21 LOCAL ZONING RESTRICTIONS.

22 (d) THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL MAINTAIN A LIST OF  
23 ALL APPROVED SALES ROOMS IN THE STATE AND SHALL MAKE THE LIST  
24 AVAILABLE ON ITS WEBSITE.

25 (e) THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY REQUEST THAT THE  
26 STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY TAKE ACTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
27 SECTION 12-43.4-601 AGAINST A LICENSED RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE  
28 APPROVED TO OPERATE A SALES ROOM IF THE LOCAL LICENSING  
29 AUTHORITY:

30 (I) DEMONSTRATES TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY THAT  
31 THE LICENSEE HAS ENGAGED IN AN UNLAWFUL ACT AS SET FORTH IN PART  
32 9 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR

37 (4) (a) A PATRON SHALL NOT BRING RETAIL OR MEDICAL  
38 MARIJUANA, RETAIL OR MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, A MEDICAL  
39 MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCT, OR A RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCT INTO  
40 A SALES ROOM.

41 (b) A PATRON OF A SALES ROOM SHALL NOT LEAVE THE PREMISES  
42 OF A SALES ROOM WITH RETAIL MARIJUANA, RETAIL MARIJUANA  
43 CONCENTRATE, OR A RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCT PURCHASED AT THE

2 (5) (a) A SALES ROOM SHALL NOT OPERATE AS A RETAIL FOOD  
3 ESTABLISHMENT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 25-4-1602 (14).

4 (b) A SALES ROOM MAY NOT SELL ALCOHOL OR TOBACCO OR  
5 NICOTINE PRODUCTS OR ALLOW THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL OR  
6 TOBACCO OR NICOTINE PRODUCTS ON SITE.

7 (6) A SALES ROOM MAY ONLY ADMIT PERSONS WHO ARE AT LEAST  
8 TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE ONTO THE PREMISES.

9 (7) (a) A SALES ROOM MAY SELL NO MORE THAN ONE GRAM OF  
10 RETAIL MARIJUANA FLOWER, ONE-QUARTER OF ONE GRAM OF RETAIL  
11 MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR TEN MILLIGRAMS OF A RETAIL MARIJUANA  
12 PRODUCT TO A PERSON AT A TIME.

13 (b) WHEN A SALES ROOM SELLS RETAIL MARIJUANA, RETAIL  
14 MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR A RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCT, AN  
15 EMPLOYEE MUST REMOVE THE PACKAGING AT THE POINT OF SALE.

16 (8) (a) A SALES ROOM AND ITS EMPLOYEES SHALL CONDUCT THE  
17 LICENSED PREMISES IN A DECENT, ORDERLY, AND RESPECTABLE MANNER  
18 AND SHALL NOT SERVE ANY PERSON WHO DISPLAYS ANY VISIBLE SIGNS OF  
19 INTOXICATION; NOR SHALL THEY PERMIT ANY PERSON WHO DISPLAYS ANY

27 (b) A SALES ROOM SHALL NOT ALLOW THE USE OF A BUTANE  
28 TORCH, BUTANE LIGHTER, OR MATCHES IN A SALES ROOM.

29 (9) A SALES ROOM AND ITS EMPLOYEES SHALL SUCCESSFULLY  
30 COMPLETE A RESPONSIBLE VENDOR PROGRAM AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO  
31 SECTION 12-43.3-1102 ANNUALLY.

32 (10) A SALES ROOM SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION REGARDING THE  
33 SAFE CONSUMPTION OF RETAIL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE OR A RETAIL  
34 MARIJUANA PRODUCT AT THE POINT OF SALE TO ALL PATRONS WHO  
35 PURCHASE SUCH A PRODUCT.

36 (11) THE WINDOWS AND DOORS OF A SALES ROOM MUST BE  
37 OPAQUE, AND THE SALES ROOM SHALL ENSURE THAT ANY RETAIL  
38 MARIJUANA, RETAIL MARIJUANA CONCENTRATE, OR RETAIL MARIJUANA  
39 PRODUCT IS NOT VISIBLE FROM OUTSIDE OF THE SALES ROOM."
