Summary / Notable Info

- Of 20 current funds / organizations: [were 14 in 2016; now 20 in 2017]
 - 4 / 20 run by govt agencies
 - 5 / 20 go directly to MULTIPLE nonprofits through a fund (as few as 11 nonprofits per fund, as high as 47)
 - 11 / 20 go straight to ONE nonprofit
 - Of those, 8 definitely have large budgets, making the tax checkoff revenue “ICING”
- There is a SMALL FEE that DOR takes from the nonprofit / fund (\$8,000?) revenue to appear on the tax return (in addition to lobbying costs to get on)
- Threshold to stay on tax checkoff was \$75,000 (starting in 3rd year on it) until new statute last year, decreasing it to \$50,000
- As of 2016, 37–38 funds / organizations have appeared
- QUEUE -- NONE IN QUEUE
