## HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Education.HB17-1082 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 9 through 13.
- 2 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 24.
- 3 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 4 Page 4, line 10, strike "22-43.7-109 (5)(a)(I)(B);" and substitute  
5 "22-43.7-109 (5)(a)(I)(B), WHICH INCLUDES HARDWARE, DEVICES, OR  
6 EQUIPMENT NECESSARY FOR INDIVIDUAL STUDENT LEARNING AND  
7 CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION, INCLUDING ACCESS TO ELECTRONIC  
8 INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS, OR NECESSARY FOR PROFESSIONAL USE BY A  
9 CLASSROOM TEACHER;".
- 10 Page 4, line 12, strike "(5) introductory portion and".
- 11 Page 4, line 17, strike "22-43.7-108 AND THE EXTENT".
- 12 Page 4, strike lines 18 and 19.
- 13 Page 4, line 20, strike "FROM EACH COUNTY OF THE STATE," and substitute  
14 "22-43.7-108,".
- 15 Page 5, strike lines 6 and 7.
- 16 Page 5, line 8, strike "43.7, FOR" and substitute:  
17 "(13) FOR".
- 18 Page 5, line 11, strike "SHALL" and substitute "MAY".
- 19 Page 5, line 12, strike "GRANTS FROM THE".
- 20 Page 5, strike line 13:
- 21 Page 5, line 14, strike "SECTION 22-43.7-104 (2)(d)." and substitute  
22 "GRANTS. IN CONJUNCTION WITH ITS ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ANNUAL  
23 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TIMELINE AS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (2)(a) OF  
24 THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL ANNUALLY NOTIFY ALL POTENTIAL

1 APPLICANTS, BY SUCH MEANS AS THE BOARD DEEMS APPROPRIATE, THAT  
2 IT WILL ACCEPT AND CONSIDER APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE  
3 IN THE FORM OF TECHNOLOGY GRANTS."

4 Page 5, line 24, strike "SECTION 22-43.7-109 (5)(a)(I)(B)." and substitute  
5 "SUBSECTION (5)(a)(I)(B) OF THIS SECTION."

6 Page 5, strike lines 25 through 27.

7 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 15 and substitute:

8 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-43.7-111, amend  
9 (1) introductory portion, (1)(a)(III), (1)(a)(IV), and (1)(d) introductory  
10 portion as follows:

11 **22-43.7-111. Reporting requirements - auditing by state**  
12 **auditor.** (1) No later than February 15, 2010, and no later than each  
13 February 15 thereafter, the board shall present a written report to the  
14 education and finance committees of the house of representatives and the  
15 senate and the capital development committee, or any successor  
16 committees, regarding the provision of financial assistance to applicants  
17 pursuant to this article ARTICLE 43.7. The report must include, at a  
18 minimum:

19 (a) An accounting of the financial assistance provided through the  
20 prior fiscal year that includes:

21 (III) A list of the public school facility capital construction  
22 projects for which financial assistance has been provided, including  
23 WHICH MUST INCLUDE A SUBLIST OF PROJECTS FOR WHICH FINANCIAL  
24 ASSISTANCE HAS BEEN PROVIDED IN THE FORM OF TECHNOLOGY GRANTS  
25 PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-43.7-109 (13), a brief description of each  
26 project, a statement of the amount and type of financial assistance  
27 provided for each project and, where applicable, the amount of financial  
28 assistance committed to be provided for but not yet provided for each  
29 project, a statement of the amount of matching moneys provided by the  
30 applicant for each project and, where applicable, the amount of matching  
31 moneys committed to be provided by the applicant but not yet provided  
32 for each project, and a summary of the reasons of the board and the state  
33 board for providing financial assistance for the project; and

34 (IV) A list of the public school facility capital construction  
35 projects for which financial assistance has been provided during the prior  
36 fiscal year, including WHICH MUST INCLUDE A SUBLIST OF PROJECTS FOR  
37 WHICH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE HAS BEEN PROVIDED IN THE FORM OF  
38 TECHNOLOGY GRANTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-43.7-109 (13), a brief  
39 description of each project, a statement of the amount and type of

1 financial assistance provided for each project, and a statement of the  
2 amount of matching moneys provided by the applicant for each project.

3 (d) A list of the financial assistance applications for public school  
4 facility capital construction that were denied financial assistance during  
5 the prior fiscal year, WHICH MUST INCLUDE A SUBLIST OF DENIED  
6 APPLICATIONS FOR PROJECTS FOR WHICH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE  
7 FORM OF TECHNOLOGY GRANTS WAS REQUESTED PURSUANT TO SECTION  
8 22-43.7-109 (13), that includes for each project:".

9 Page 1, strike lines 101 through 106 and substitute "CONCERNING  
10 CLARIFICATION THAT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE "BUILDING  
11 EXCELLENT SCHOOLS TODAY ACT" INCLUDES TECHNOLOGY GRANTS."
