Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments which may be subsequently adopted.)

Authorizes the state department of social services to contract with units of local government and nongovernmental agencies for the purpose of establishing programs and facilities for victims of domestic abuse and their dependents. Provides for funding of such programs and facilities by allowing taxpayers to designate a portion of their yearly state tax refund for this purpose.
