SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Business, Labor, & Technology.SB16-040 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 5, after "12-43.3-307," insert "**amend** (1)
2 (a);".

3 Page 3, after line 8 insert:

4 "(a) A person until the annual fee therefore has been paid;".

5 Page 4, after line 7 insert:

6 "SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-305, add
7 (4) as follows:

8 **12-43.3-305. State licensing authority - application and**
9 **issuance procedures.** (4) A LICENSE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE
10 IS VALID FOR THREE YEARS.

11 SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-311, amend
12 (2) (b); add (1.5) as follows:

13 **12-43.3-311. License renewal.** (1.5) NOTWITHSTANDING THE
14 PROVISIONS OF SECTION 12-43.3-307 (2) (c), IF A LICENSEE, WHEN
15 APPLYING FOR RENEWAL, PROVIDES CERTIFICATION THAT THERE ARE NO
16 CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES AFFECTING LICENSURE SINCE THE INITIAL
17 APPLICATION OR LAST RENEWAL OR PROVIDES DETAILS REGARDING ANY
18 CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES, THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL NOT
19 REQUIRE A LICENSEE TO SUBMIT A NEW BACKGROUND CHECK, INCLUDING
20 A FINGERPRINT-BASED CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK, DURING THE
21 RENEWAL PROCESS.

22 (2) (b) The state and local licensing authorities may not accept a
23 late renewal application more than ninety days after the expiration of a
24 licensee's permanent annual license. A licensee whose permanent annual
25 license has been expired for more than ninety days shall not cultivate,
26 manufacture, distribute, or sell any medical marijuana until all required
27 licenses have been obtained."

8 IS VALID FOR THREE YEARS.

9 SECTION 14. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-310, add
10 (1.5) as follows:

11 **12-43.4-310. License renewal.** (1.5) IF A LICENSEE, WHEN
12 APPLYING FOR RENEWAL, PROVIDES CERTIFICATION THAT THERE ARE NO
13 CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES AFFECTING LICENSURE SINCE THE INITIAL
14 APPLICATION OR LAST RENEWAL OR PROVIDES DETAILS REGARDING ANY
15 CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES, THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL NOT
16 REQUIRE A LICENSEE TO SUBMIT A NEW BACKGROUND CHECK, INCLUDING
17 A FINGERPRINT-BASED CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK, DURING THE
18 RENEWAL PROCESS."
