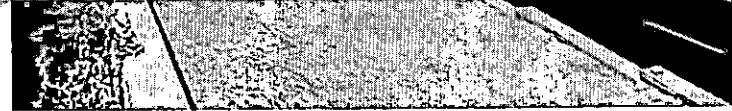




Promises Made,

Completed in November 2008, the Austin Bluffs Parkway Interchange at Union Boulevard reduces congestion and accidents by streamlining east-west and north-south traffic.



**Baptist Road Widening:** Baptist Road was widened from I-25 east to Tarr Drive (shown above). A new project (currently in the design phase) will widen Baptist Road from I-25 west to Mitchell Avenue, including the construction of a roundabout at the Baptist Road/Old Denver Highway intersection and a grade-separated crossing at the railroad tracks and Monument Creek north of the existing road.



El Paso County's South Academy Boulevard project, completed in 2010, improves the access to Pikes Peak Community College and Fort Carson.



The Manitou Avenue Rehabilitation Project, completed in May 2013, was a multi-million-dollar PPRTA/federal-grant-funded project that involved transportation and pedestrian improvements, including replacing pavement and sidewalks, landscaping, and installing underground drainage and utilities.
