HB18-1152 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 20, strike "**definitions - repeal.**" and
2 substitute "**definitions.**".
- 3 Page 3, lines 1 and 2, strike "THIS SUBSECTION (3)(a)(X)(D) IS REPEALED,
4 EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2021."
- 5 Page 3, after line 2 insert:
- 6 **"SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-72-204, **amend**
7 **(2)(a)(IX)(B)** as follows:
8 **24-72-204. Allowance or denial of inspection - grounds -**
9 **procedure - appeal - definitions.** (2) (a) The custodian may deny the
10 right of inspection of the following records, unless otherwise provided by
11 law, on the ground that disclosure to the applicant would be contrary to
12 the public interest:
13 (IX) (B) Upon conclusion of a civil or administrative investigation
14 that is closed because no further investigation, discipline, or other agency
15 response is warranted, all records not exempt pursuant to any other law
16 are open to inspection; except that the custodian may remove the name or
17 other personal identifying or financial information of witnesses or targets
18 of such closed investigations from investigative records prior to
19 inspection. THIS SUBSECTION (2)(a)(IX)(B) APPLIES TO THE JUDICIAL
20 DEPARTMENT OF STATE GOVERNMENT."
