HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Transportation & Energy.

SB18-001 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 6, line 14, strike "either".
- 2 Page 6, strike lines 15 through 17 and substitute "the November 2018  
3 general election for a ballot issue submitted by".
- 4 Page 7, line 12, strike "fees;" and substitute "fees; and".
- 5 Page 7, strike lines 13 through 20 and substitute:  
6 "(b) It is necessary and".
- 7 Page 7, line 23, strike "2019 statewide" and substitute "2018 general".
- 8 Page 12, line 3, after "PROJECTS." add "EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED  
9 IN SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL EXPEND  
10 MONEY TRANSFERRED FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE HIGHWAY  
11 FUND PURSUANT SECTION 24-75-219 (5)(b) EXCLUSIVELY FOR  
12 MAINTENANCE, OPERATION, AND CAPACITY EXPANSION OF AND SAFETY  
13 IMPROVEMENTS TO THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM."
- 14 Page 12, strike lines 4 through 27.
- 15 Strike page 13.
- 16 Page 14, strike lines 1 through 9 and substitute:  
17 "(2) (a) IF A MAJORITY OF THE REGISTERED ELECTORS VOTING ON  
18 THE BALLOT ISSUE THAT AUTHORIZES THE STATE TO ISSUE  
19 TRANSPORTATION REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES THAT IS SUBMITTED FOR  
20 THEIR APPROVAL OR REJECTION AT THE NOVEMBER 2018 GENERAL  
21 ELECTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 43-4-705 (13)(b) VOTE "YES/FOR", THE  
22 DEPARTMENT SHALL EXPEND MONEY TRANSFERRED FROM THE GENERAL  
23 FUND TO THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND PURSUANT SECTION 24-75-219 (5)(b)  
24 FIRST, TO THE EXTENT NEEDED TO MAKE THE FULL AMOUNT OF PAYMENTS  
25 DUE ON THE NOTES, AND THEREAFTER EXCLUSIVELY FOR MAINTENANCE,  
26 OPERATION, AND CAPACITY EXPANSION OF AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO  
27 THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM.  
28 (b) (I) THIS SUBSECTION (2) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1,  
29 2019, IF A MAJORITY OF THE REGISTERED ELECTORS VOTING ON THE  
30 BALLOT ISSUE THAT AUTHORIZES THE STATE TO ISSUE TRANSPORTATION  
31 REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES THAT IS SUBMITTED FOR THEIR APPROVAL  
32 OR REJECTION AT THE NOVEMBER 2018 GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO  
33 SECTION 43-4-705 (13)(b) VOTE "NO/AGAINST".

1 (II) THIS SUBSECTION (2)(b) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1,  
2 2019, IF A MAJORITY OF THE REGISTERED ELECTORS VOTING ON THE  
3 BALLOT ISSUE THAT AUTHORIZES THE STATE TO ISSUE TRANSPORTATION  
4 REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES THAT IS SUBMITTED FOR THEIR APPROVAL  
5 OR REJECTION AT THE NOVEMBER 2018 GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO  
6 SECTION 43-4-705 (13)(b) VOTE "YES/FOR".

7 Page 17, line 2, strike "2019 STATEWIDE" and substitute "2018 GENERAL".

8 Page 17, line 23, strike "2019 STATEWIDE" and substitute "2018  
9 GENERAL".

10 Page 18, line 13, strike "2019" and substitute "2018".

11 Page 18, line 23, strike "2019" and substitute "2018".

12 Page 18, strike line 27.

13 Page 19, strike lines 1 through 7.

14 Page 19, line 8, strike "1, 2020," and substitute:

15 "(V) (A) THIS SUBSECTION 13 (b) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE  
16 JANUARY 1, 2019,".

17 Page 19, line 10, strike "(C)" and substitute "(B)".

18 Page 19, line 11, strike "2020," and substitute "2019,".

19 Page 20, strike lines 21 through 27.

20 Page 21, strike lines 1 through 14 and substitute:

21 "(b) (I) THIS SUBSECTION (2) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1,  
22 2019, IF A MAJORITY OF THE REGISTERED ELECTORS VOTING ON THE  
23 BALLOT ISSUE THAT AUTHORIZES THE STATE TO ISSUE TRANSPORTATION  
24 REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES THAT IS SUBMITTED FOR THEIR APPROVAL  
25 OR REJECTION AT THE NOVEMBER 2018 GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO

29 BALLOT ISSUE THAT AUTHORIZES THE STATE TO ISSUE TRANSPORTATION  
30 REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES THAT IS SUBMITTED FOR THEIR APPROVAL  
31 OR REJECTION AT THE NOVEMBER 2018 GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO  
32 SECTION 43-4-705 (13)(b) VOTE "YES/FOR".

1 Page 21, strike lines 18 through 27.

2 Page 22, strike lines 1 through 4 and substitute:

3 "(2) Section 4 of this act takes effect only if a majority of the  
4 registered electors voting on the ballot issue that authorizes the state to  
5 issue transportation revenue anticipation notes that is submitted for their  
6 approval or rejection at the November 2018 general election pursuant to  
7 section 43-4-705 (13)(b), Colorado Revised Statutes, enacted in section  
8 10 of this act, vote "Yes/For", and, in such case, section 4 of this act."

9 Page 1, strike lines 110 through 113.

10 Page 2, strike line 101 and substitute "SPECIFIED IN THE BILL AND  
11 REQUIRING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO".

12 Page 2, line 103, strike "2019 STATEWIDE" and substitute "2018  
13 GENERAL".
