

PLEASE OPPOSE TIER 1 / TIER 2 COLLAPSE IN SB18-167

- Keeping 2 Tier system does not risk federal sanctions; there is time to develop a better solution that will work for ALL stakeholders
- Tier 2 includes small entities that lack sufficient staff to comply with Tier 1 requirements
- Tier 2 members are committed to an interim stakeholder process to assess the best way to move forward
- Mandating Tier 1 membership will not increase safety
- Mandating Tier 1 has SIGNIFICANT COSTS TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS for no increase in value.
