HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Finance.

HB16-1324 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend the Health, Insurance, and Environment Committee Report, dated  
2 March 17, 2016, strike page 1.
- 3 Page 2 of the report, strike lines 1 through 7 and substitute:
- 4 "Amend printed bill, page 2, line 20, strike "DISPENSED." and substitute  
5 "DISPENSED, BUT ONLY".
- 6 Page 2 of the report, strike lines 11 through 17 and substitute "IN THE  
7 STATE OF RESIDENCE AND A COPY OF THE MOST RECENT INSPECTION  
8 RECEIVED FROM A BOARD-APPROVED THIRD-PARTY ENTITY THAT INSPECTS  
9 PHARMACY OUTLETS, FOR WHICH THIRD-PARTY INSPECTION THE  
10 NONRESIDENT PHARMACY OUTLET SHALL OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ON AN  
11 ANNUAL BASIS, AND THE BOARD APPROVES THE INSPECTION REPORTS AS  
12 SATISFACTORILY DEMONSTRATING PROOF OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE  
13 BOARD'S OWN INSPECTION PROCEDURE AND STANDARDS."
- 14 Page 3 of the bill, strike lines 5 and 6 and substitute "DRUG OUTLET MAY  
15 COMPOUND AND DISTRIBUTE A DRUG TO A".
- 16 Page 3 of the bill, after line 20 insert:
- 17 "(3) A LICENSED VETERINARIAN SHALL NOT ADMINISTER OR  
18 DISPENSE A COMPOUNDED DRUG MAINTAINED FOR OFFICE STOCK  
19 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION OR FOR OFFICE USE PURSUANT TO SECTION  
20 12-42.5-118 (6) (b) (II) WITHOUT A VALID VETERINARIAN-CLIENT-PATIENT  
21 RELATIONSHIP IN PLACE AT THE TIME OF ADMINISTERING THE  
22 COMPOUNDED DRUG TO AN ANIMAL PATIENT OR DISPENSING THE  
23 COMPOUNDED DRUG TO A CLIENT.
- 24 (4) TO COMPOUND AND DISTRIBUTE A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE  
25 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION OR SECTION 12-42.5-118 (6) (b) (II), A  
26 REGISTERED PRESCRIPTION DRUG OUTLET SHALL POSSESS A VALID  
27 MANUFACTURING REGISTRATION FROM THE FEDERAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT  
28 ADMINISTRATION."
- 29 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly."
- 30 Page 2 of the committee report, strike lines 27 through 32 and substitute

1 "PHARMACEUTICALS IN THE STATE OF RESIDENCE AND A COPY OF THE  
2 MOST RECENT INSPECTION RECEIVED FROM A BOARD-APPROVED  
3 THIRD-PARTY ENTITY THAT INSPECTS PHARMACY OUTLETS, FOR WHICH  
4 THIRD-PARTY INSPECTION THE NONRESIDENT PHARMACY OUTLET SHALL  
5 OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, AND THE BOARD APPROVES  
6 THE INSPECTION REPORTS AS SATISFACTORILY DEMONSTRATING PROOF OF  
7 COMPLIANCE WITH THE BOARD'S OWN INSPECTION PROCEDURE AND  
8 STANDARDS."

9 Page 4 of the bill, strike lines 15 and 16 and substitute:

10 "(6) THE BOARD MAY PROMULGATE RULES AS NECESSARY  
11 CONCERNING COMPOUNDED VETERINARY PHARMACEUTICALS PURSUANT  
12 TO THIS SECTION AND SECTION 12-42.5-118 (6) (b) (II)."

13 Page 4 of the bill, line 26, strike "(3)" and substitute "(5)".

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
