HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.HB16-1454 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 11, lines 1 and 2, strike "(32); and add (49.3)"
- 2 and substitute "(32)".
- 3 Page 11, strike lines 8 through 20.
- 4 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 5 Page 11, strike lines 26 and 27 and substitute:
 - 6 "(j) The elector's affiliation. ~~if any, if the eligible elector desires~~
 - 7 ~~to affiliate with any political party or political organization. If this~~
 - 8 ~~question is not answered, the elector shall be registered as "unaffiliated".~~
 - 9 ~~Only the eligible elector personally shall declare the eligible elector's~~
 - 10 ~~affiliation."~~
- 11 Strike pages 12 and 13.
- 12 Page 14, strike lines 1 through 12.
- 13 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 14 Page 15, line 3, strike "election AND THE" and substitute "election."
- 15 Page 15, strike lines 4 through 27 and substitute:
 - 16 "SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-7-201, amend (2)
 - 17 as follows:
 - 18 **1-7-201. Voting at primary election.** (2) If the name is found on
 - 19 the registration list, the election judge having charge of the list shall
 - 20 likewise repeat the elector's name and present the elector with the party
 - 21 ballot of the political party affiliation last recorded. ~~If unaffiliated, the~~
 - 22 ~~eligible elector shall openly declare to the election judges the name of the~~
 - 23 ~~political party with which the elector wishes to affiliate, complete the~~
 - 24 ~~approved form for voter registration information changes, and initial the~~
 - 25 ~~registration list in the space provided. Declaration of affiliation with a~~
 - 26 ~~political party shall be separately dated and signed or dated and initialed~~
 - 27 ~~by the eligible elector in such manner that the elector clearly~~
 - 28 ~~acknowledges that the affiliation has been properly recorded. Thereupon,~~



- 1 ~~the election judges shall deliver the appropriate party ballot to the eligible~~
- 2 ~~elector. Eligible electors who decline to state an affiliation with a political~~
- 3 ~~party that is participating in the primary shall not be entitled to vote at the~~
- 4 ~~primary election."~~

- 6 Page 16, line 10, strike "(2.3) (a), (2.3) (b), and (2.3) (c)" and substitute
- 7 "(2.3) (a)".

- 8 Page 16, strike lines 18 through 26.

- 9 Page 18, line 15, strike "VOTING IN PRIMARY ELECTIONS".

- 10 Page 18, strike lines 16 through 18.

- 11 Page 19, line 4, strike "election, as provided in section 1-7-201 (2), or
- 12 the" and substitute "election as provided in section 1-7-201 (2), or the".

- 13 Page 19, strike line 5 and substitute "elector may declare his or her
- 14 political party or political organization".

- 15 Page 19, line 6, strike "affiliation" and substitute "affiliation".

- 16 Page 19, line 8, strike "AN UNAFFILIATED ELECTOR MAY".

- 17 Page 19, strike lines 9 through 14.

- 18 Page 20, strike lines 2 through 5.

- 19 Renumber succeeding subsection accordingly.

- 20 Page 20, line 6, strike "12, 13, and 14" and substitute "10, 11, and 12".
