Colorado Disability Opportunity Office

HB 1360 creates the Colorado Disability Opportunity Office in the Colorado Department of Labor and Employment. Establishing CDOO in statute will ensure that future administrations continue to work to meet the disability community's needs.

B

HB 1360:

- Creates the Disability Opportunity Office (CDOO) in the CO Department of Labor and Employment
- Requires CDOO to develop a statewide plan for economic stability for people with disabilities
- Serve as a resource for agencies on all matters related to disability
- Make recommendations to the Governor concerning disability policy
- CDOO serves the overall purpose of ensuring that the disabled are meaningfully integrated into civic and social life and that state agencies are meeting the community's needs.
- Also transfers the Disability Funding Committee to CDOO
