The concurrent resolution requires that if the governor convenes the general assembly by proclamation for the purpose of addressing a state revenue shortfall or other state budgetary issue, the governor shall not limit the scope of the special session to only a portion of the budget and shall make the proclamation broad enough so that the general assembly can consider the entirety of the state budget and craft a comprehensive solution to the revenue shortfall or other state budgetary issue.”</p> <p>So this bill would amend our state constitution to create a good old check on Executive Powers, and protect the public from the partisan meanderings currently happening in our state!</p> <p>Further it limits the targeting an issue so that the public in the end has been manipulated further by confusing legislation, and basically, steering thought and fact into corners.</p> <p>I will say it is truly tragic that in this day and age we have to create legislation to coral our own supposed elected representatives to remember they work for WE THE PEOPLE!</p>
