At the time, we didn’t fully realize the popularity and potential of sports betting, but from the start, revenues have snowballed. We’ve now generated over \$65 million for Colorado’s water since DD’s inception. Colorado Water Conservation Board has put these funds to such good use, funding hundreds of projects all around the state. The latest grant round was oversubscribed by \$8.2 million.         </p> <p>           Proposition DD revenues have risen so much that they’re now projected to exceed the \$29 million TABOR cap as soon as this year, and if not this year, certainly next year — and EVERY year after that into the future. Without a change to the law by Colorado voters, any revenues received above the cap must be returned.
