

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Business Affairs & Labor.

HB24-1121 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 7, line 26, after "(a)" insert "(I)".

2 Page 8, strike lines 14 through 19 and substitute:

3 "(II) A MANUFACTURER SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO AN
4 INDEPENDENT REPAIR PROVIDER OR OWNER, ON FAIR AND REASONABLE
5 TERMS, ANY DOCUMENTATION, EMBEDDED SOFTWARE, TOOL, PART, OR
6 OTHER DEVICE OR IMPLEMENT THAT THE MANUFACTURER PROVIDES FOR
7 EFFECTING THE SERVICES OF MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, OR DIAGNOSIS ON THE
8 MANUFACTURER'S DIGITAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT.

9 (III) WITH RESPECT TO PARTS, A MANUFACTURER COMPLIES WITH
10 THIS SUBSECTION (1)(a) IF A CONTRACTOR MAKES THE PARTS AVAILABLE
11 TO AN INDEPENDENT REPAIR PROVIDER OR OWNER ON BEHALF OF THE
12 MANUFACTURER.

13 (b) (I) With respect to AGRICULTURAL equipment OR A POWERED
14 WHEELCHAIR that contains an electronic security lock or other
15 security-related function, a manufacturer shall, with fair and reasonable
16 terms and costs, AS APPLIED TO AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT OR POWERED
17 WHEELCHAIRS,".

18 Page 9, after line 1 insert:

19 "(II) THE REQUIREMENT SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (1)(b)(I) OF
20 THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO DIGITAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT.".

21 Page 10, after line 2 insert:

22 "(g) OUTSIDE-THE-METER COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL
23 ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING POWER DISTRIBUTION EQUIPMENT,
24 AND ANY TOOLS, ATTACHMENTS, ACCESSORIES, COMPONENTS, AND
25 REPLACEMENT AND REPAIR PARTS OF THE ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT.".

26 Renumber succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

27 Page 10, line 16, before "ANTI-THEFT" insert "PRIVACY OR".

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
