## REVISOR'S NOTE

NOTE: In the preparation of the 2023 Colorado Revised Statutes, the Office of Legislative Legal Services has compiled, edited, and arranged the statutes to include changes made at the 2023 Regular Session and in accordance with article 5 of title 2, Colorado Revised Statutes.
