Timothy Broderick For Boulder County Government	<p>Good afternoon Chair Roberts, committee members, and Sen. Simpson: My name is Tim Broderick, and I am the Senior Sustainability Strategist for Boulder County's Office of Sustainability, Climate Action, and Resiliency.</p> <p>Please accept this written testimony to express Boulder County's strong support for SB 152, Regenerative Agriculture Tax Credit. Boulder County has deeply invested in regenerative agriculture to improve the county's climate resiliency, mitigation of carbon, and food security. For example, this past month the county announced a new \$1.1 million grant program for both private and public lands to improve soil health through regenerative agriculture practices. This new grant program was developed and deployed in partnership with the Colorado Department of Agriculture. Boulder County supports SB 152 because we view the legislation as another avenue to fund and guide regenerative agriculture work within the county and across Colorado. We welcome the Colorado Department of Agriculture in having a formal process for certifying farms that are implementing regenerative agriculture practices. We hope to fold this certification process into our existing efforts.</p> <p>And finally, we believe this bill incentivizes restaurants to prioritize sourcing from local farmers who badly need stronger markets. Thank you for your consideration of Boulder County's perspective on SB 152. Again, Boulder County respectfully asks for your YES vote on SB 152.</p>
