<p>Linda Bissett For themselves</p>	<p>February 12, 2024</p> <p>My name is Linda Bissett I am from Jefferson County.</p> <p>I support Bill24-1145 for the simple reason that it will cut on the outrageous waste of tax payer dollars to print and mail hundreds of thousands of unnecessary ballots only to have them thrown in the trash or returned as Undeliverable at an additional cost of \$1.87 a piece!</p> <p>Estimates of the cost to print and mail ballots are from \$4 to \$8 a ballot depending on the county's contract with the printer. During the Primary Unaffiliated Electors are mailed both the Democrat and Republican ballots which incurs the additional cost to print duplicate ballots and the extra weight to mail them.</p> <p>The voter rolls are apparently not up to date when counties like El Paso had approx. 28,000 Undeliverable ballots in the Nov 2023. Arapahoe County has 21 pallets of undeliverable ballots stacked in their warehouse containing an estimated 3 to 400,000 ballots. That is over 100,000 Undeliverable ballots returned every election in ONE county! (21 pallets of USPS flats containing 300-500 envelopes, stacked 3 wide, 2 deep and 7 high)</p> <p>With cleaner voter rolls this waste of tax dollars, your money and mine, will be minimized by updating an Elector's mailing address on a regular basis, choosing to have only one ballot mailed, or even more important, having the opportunity to NOT have a ballot mail at all for those of us who respect the security of elections and understand that Mail in Ballots completely lack of chain of custody. President Carter said in the Baker-Carter Report from 2006, "Much of the voter fraud taking place today occurs not at the polling place but through absentee ballots."</p> <p>Thank you Representative DeGraaf.
