Committee on Local Government & Housing.

SB26-001 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, after line 1 insert:

2 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 29-1-204.5, **amend**
3 (7.5)(c); and **add** (7.5)(d) as follows:

4 **29-1-204.5. Establishment of multijurisdictional housing**
5 **authorities.**

6 (c) The questions proposed to the registered electors ~~under~~
7 ~~paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection~~ PURSUANT TO SUBSECTIONS
8 (7.5)(a) AND (7.5)(b) OF THIS SECTION shall be submitted at a general
9 election, BIENNIAL LOCAL ELECTION, or any election to be held on the first
10 Tuesday in November of an odd-numbered year. The action shall not take
11 effect unless a majority of the registered electors voting thereon at the
12 election vote in favor thereof. The election shall be conducted in
13 substantially the same manner as county elections and the county clerk
14 and recorder of each county in which the election is conducted shall assist
15 the authority in conducting the election. The authority shall pay the costs
16 incurred by each county in conducting such an election. No ~~moneys~~
17 MONEY of the authority may be used to urge or oppose passage of an
18 election required under this section.

19 (d) THE CONTRACT ESTABLISHING THE AUTHORITY MAY BE
20 CONDITIONED UPON VOTER APPROVAL BY THE INDIVIDUAL CONTRACTING
21 JURISDICTION AS SUCH TERMS MAY BE DEFINED IN THE CONTRACT. THE
22 QUESTION OF ESTABLISHING THE AUTHORITY MAY BE COMBINED WITH A
23 QUESTION ABOUT A TAX, IMPACT FEE, MULTIPLE-FISCAL YEAR DEBT, OR
24 OTHER FINANCIAL OBLIGATION REQUIRED BY SUBSECTIONS (7.5)(a) OR
25 (7.5)(b) OF THIS SECTION."
