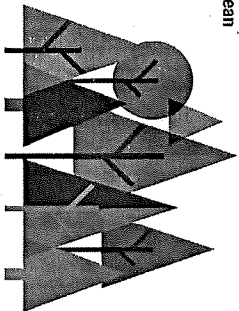
**PRIMARY WATER FILTER

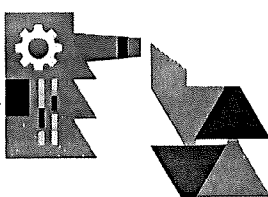
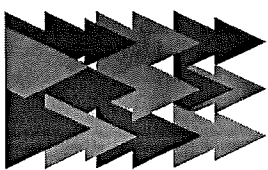
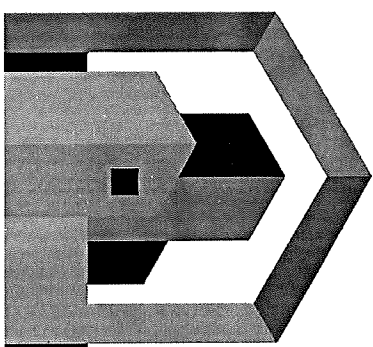
Management strategies elevate natural processes to create landscapes resilient to climate change and disease.
