

FIRST REPORT OF FIRST CONFERENCE COMMITTEE
ON HB26-1084

THIS REPORT AMENDS THE
REREVISED BILL

To the President of the Senate and the
Speaker of the House of Representatives:

Your first conference committee appointed on HB26-1084, concerning voter transparency requirements to expand information about the funding of initiated statewide ballot measures, and, in connection therewith, requiring the abstract of the fiscal impact statement for certain initiated statewide ballot measures to describe the measure's likely effect on the main areas of state expenditure, has met and reports that it has agreed upon the following:

1. That the House accede to the Senate amendments made to the bill, as the amendments appear in the rerevised bill.

2. That, under the authority granted the committee to consider matters not at issue between the two houses, the following amendments be recommended:

Amend rerevised bill, page 3, strike line 13 and substitute "(1)(b)(V), (1)(b)(VI), and (1)(f) as follows:".

Page 4, line 21, strike "AND".

Page 5, strike line 2 and substitute "(3)(i)(I); AND

(VI) FOR AN INITIATED MEASURE THAT REQUIRES EXISTING REVENUE SOURCES TO BE REALLOCATED AND SPENT IN A PARTICULAR WAY, A DESCRIPTION OF THE MEASURE'S LIKELY EFFECT ON THE THREE LARGEST AREAS OF PROGRAM EXPENDITURE, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1-40-106 (3)(i)(I).

(f) WHEN PREPARING THE FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT REQUIRED

BY THIS SUBSECTION (1), THE DIRECTOR OF RESEARCH OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL INCLUDE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED IN THE ABSTRACT AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTIONS (1)(b)(V) AND (1)(b)(VI) OF THIS SECTION."

Page 5, strike lines 3 through 15 and substitute:

"SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state institutions."

Page 1, line 104, strike "ABSTRACT OF THE".
