Bennett Rutledge Against themselves	<p>Chair Froelich, and members of the committee, good morning,</p> <p>Bill HB26-1420 - Wind Energy Facilities Light-Mitigating Technology, seems to add confusion to the Colorado Revised Statutes. The FAA, The FCC, and any other applicable federal agencies seem to have the regulation of light-mitigating technology well covered, judging from the language of the bill itself.
