

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.

HB26-1037 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
2 substitute:

3 **"SECTION 1. Short title.** The short title of this act is the "Fourth
4 Amendment is Not for Sale Act".

5 **SECTION 2. Legislative intent.** It is the general assembly's
6 intent that, upon approval of the ballot question in section 4 of this act,
7 the general assembly may develop a statutory framework regarding access
8 to and protection of an individual's private personal data, which may
9 include further guardrails for the protection of private personal data and
10 the means to dispute issues related to the access of private personal data.

11 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 16-3-303.3 as
12 follows:

13 **16-3-303.3. Personal data - warrant required.**

14 A SEARCH WARRANT IS REQUIRED IN ORDER FOR LAW
15 ENFORCEMENT TO ACCESS A PERSON'S PRIVATE PERSONAL DATA,
16 ENSURING THE INDIVIDUAL PROTECTIONS GRANTED UNDER COLORADO
17 LAW.

18 **SECTION 4. Refer to people under referendum.** At the
19 election held on November 3, 2026, the secretary of state shall submit this
20 act by its ballot title to the registered electors of the state for their
21 approval or rejection. Each elector voting at the election may cast a vote
22 either "Yes/For" or "No/Against" on the following ballot title: "Shall
23 there be a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes creating new law to
24 require a search warrant in order for law enforcement to access a person's
25 private personal data?" Except as otherwise provided in section 1-40-123,
26 Colorado Revised Statutes, if a majority of the electors voting on the
27 ballot title vote "Yes/For", then the act will become part of the Colorado
28 Revised Statutes."

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
