

FIRST REPORT OF FIRST CONFERENCE COMMITTEE
ON HB24-1135

THIS REPORT AMENDS THE
REREVISED BILL

To the President of the Senate and the
Speaker of the House of Representatives:

Your first conference committee appointed on HB24-1135, concerning offenses related to requirements for operating a vehicle, and, in connection therewith, making an appropriation, has met and reports that it has agreed upon the following:

1. That the House accede to the Senate amendments made to the bill, as the amendments appear in the rerevised bill, with the following changes:

Amend rerevised bill, page 4, strike line 27 and substitute:

"(b) AS PART OF ITS STUDY, THE COMMITTEE SHALL REQUEST INPUT FROM THE COLORADO DISTRICT ATTORNEYS' COUNCIL, THE OFFICE OF STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER, PRIVATE CRIMINAL DEFENSE ATTORNEYS, PLAINTIFF AND DEFENSE COUNSEL WHO HANDLE CIVIL CLAIMS RELATED TO TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS, VICTIM REPRESENTATIVES, CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORM ORGANIZATIONS IN COLORADO, THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT, THE COLORADO STATE PATROL, AND OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.".

Page 5, strike lines 1 and 2.

2. That, under the authority granted the committee to consider matters not at issue between the two houses, the following amendment be recommended:

Amend rerevised bill, page 7, strike lines 9 and 10 and substitute:

"SECTION 4. Effective date - applicability. This act takes effect upon passage; except that section 1 of this act takes effect August

1, 2024, and applies to offenses committed on or after said date.".
