

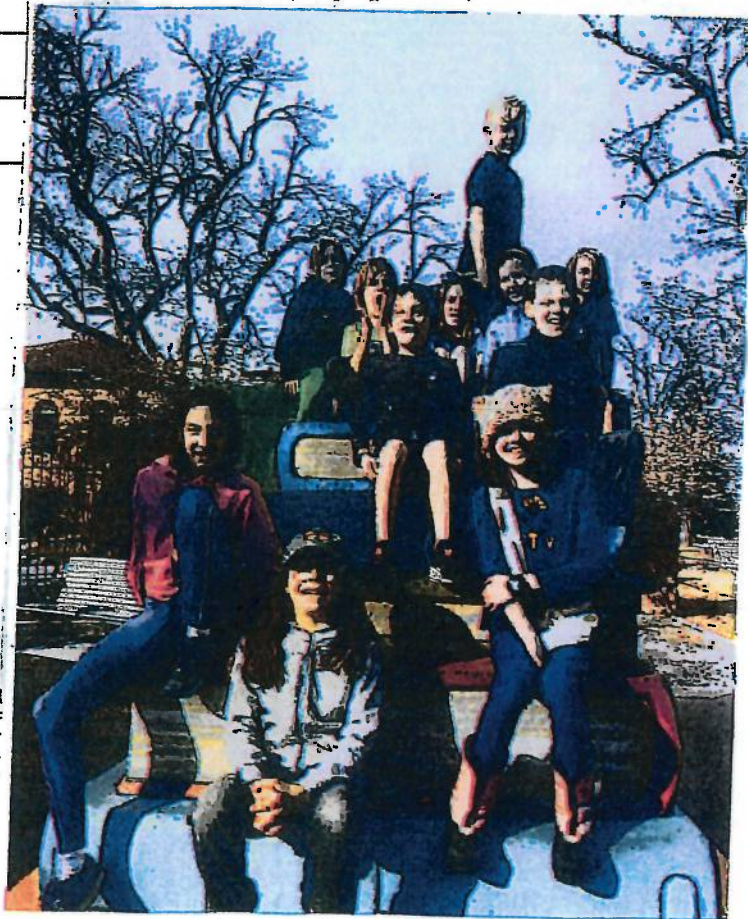
Dear members of the house Agricultural water and natural Resources Committee,
